

Parallel Development Checklist

Managing multiple features simultaneously

When to Go Parallel:

- Feature A is blocked (waiting on data, review, etc.)
- Features are independent (no code overlap)
- You're comfortable with Git branches
- You can track 2-3 things at once

The 3-Branch Rule:

Keep maximum 3 active feature branches:

- Branch 1: Active development
- Branch 2: In review or waiting
- Branch 3: Testing or polishing

Workflow:

```
git checkout -b feature-auth      # Start feature 1
[Build until blocked]

git checkout -b feature-export    # Start feature 2
[Build while feature 1 waits]

git checkout feature-auth        # Back to feature 1
[Now unblocked, continue]

git checkout main
git merge feature-auth          # Ship feature 1
```

Merge fast, branch often, stay organized.
